- Coordinating the development of a statistical strategic plan for the Cayman Islands Government.

- Master's Degree in Statistics and at least eight (8) years of experience with a statistical agency, including experience in census planning and implementation; survey methodology and development of statistical models including population projection models; economic statistics including system of national accounts or balance of payments compilation, consumer price index and labor force surveys; and at least five (5) years are in a supervisory capacity (head of unit or section in a statistical agency) OR
- Bachelor's Degree in Statistics, with at least 10 years (10) years experience with a statistical agency, including experience in areas listed above; and at least six (6) years in a supervisory capacity (head of unit or section in a statistical agency).
- Significant work experience in statistical and economic analysis software packages.
- Able to research, assimilate and analyze facts, to set priorities and ensure accuracy and conformity of procedures, possess astuteness in dealing with sensitive and confidential matters, and be able to train and develop staff.
