CAYMAN ISLANDS

Report of the Registrar General on the Census of 1921

The Census was taken under the provisions of The Census Law 1920 and enumerates the Dependency on the 24th April 1921.

2. The total population is 5,253 (2,216 males, 3,037 females) as compared with 5,564 in 1911 and 4,322 in 1891. As compared with the last previous census there has been a shrinkage in numbers by $5\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. The disparity between males and females is accounted for by the absence of men in the fishing and trading vessels and by the numbers employed in Cuba and in the sea-board ports of the Gulf of Mexico and the western Caribbean.
