


Occupational Wage Survey 2017 Report Summary



Overall Indicators

Highest number of employee returns by industry:












Number of Employees by Firm Size

Occupational Wage Survey 2017 Report Summary



Average Basic Earnings

CI\$47,748 annually is the average basic earnings (salary/wages + Overtime pay) for the 282 occupational types that responded to Occupational Wage Survey 2017.

The Median basic annual

earnings was **CI\$39,732**, across all industries.

- 11,347 (61.5%) employees earned at most the average basic earnings of CI\$47,748.
- 9,330 employees earned the median basic earnings of CI\$39,732 or less.
- 4,596 employees earned the highest 25% of average basic earnings.

Average Total Compensation

CI\$54,600 is the average total compensation (basic earnings, commissions, bonuses, gratuities, tips, acting/duty allowances) earned by employees annually, across all employment industries.

The Median total annual

compensation was **CI\$44,004** across all industries.

- 12,043 (64.6%) employees earned at most the average total compensation of CI\$54,600.
- 9,320 employees earned the median total compensation or CI\$44,004 or less.
- 4,657 employees earned the top 25% of average total compensation.
