

Statistical Publication and Dissemination Calendar

This Calendar is issued by the Economics and Statistics Office (Cayman Islands Government) as approved by the Cabinet in compliance with the Statistics Act (2016 Revision), which provides that official statistics be published “in accordance with the annual publication and dissemination calendar as the Cabinet shall direct.”

Official statistics are those that are collected and compiled by the Economics and Statistics Office in accordance with the Statistics Act (2016 Revision) and any subsequent amendments thereto. All surveys and data collection activities required in the production of official statistics are approved by the Cabinet in accordance with Section 7 of the Law. **The release dates below are the target dates for releasing the reports to the public; however, the reports may also be released earlier.** The reports will be released through www.eso.ky

<p>Annual Foreign Trade Statistics Report 2025 The Foreign Trade Report details the value of merchandise imports and exports. Merchandise imports are compiled and categorised by (i) the <i>Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4)</i> issued by the United Nations Statistics Division, (ii) broad economic classification, (iii) country of origin, (iv) port of entry, and (v) quarter of the year.</p>	<p>May 31, 2026</p>
<p>Balance of Payments and International Investment Position Report 2025 The Balance of Payments Report summarises the economic and financial transactions of the residents of the Cayman Islands with residents of other territories. These transactions comprise the current accounts (trade in goods and services, income, and current transfers), and financial and capital accounts. The BOP Report is generated from the results of an annual survey of establishments using the methodology prescribed in the <i>International Balance of Payments Manual (6th Edition)</i>.</p>	<p>December 31, 2026</p>
<p>Compendium of Statistics 2025 The Compendium is a compilation of local statistics from various government and non-government organizations. It covers a wide range of areas, including demography, vital statistics, national income and prices, key economic sectors, education, health and protective services, environment, transportation and communication, infrastructure, etc.</p>	<p>September 30, 2026</p>

<p>Consumer Price Index (CPI) Reports The CPI is a measure of the country's general price level, while its change from one period to the next (the inflation rate) indicates the overall price movement. The quarterly CPI Reports are based on the 2023/24-based CPI basket comprising more than 2,200 items from a total of 337 providers in Grand Cayman. <p>Cost of Living Report The Cost of Living (CoL) is a measure of a country's cost of living based on the dollar value of essential goods and services. <p>Human Development Index 2024 The Human Development Index (HDI) is a summary measure of achievements in three key dimensions of human development: a long and healthy life (Health Index), access to knowledge (Education Index), and a decent standard of living (Income Index).</p>	<p>March 31, 2026</p>
<p>Labor Force Survey Reports The Labor Force Survey (LFS) is conducted twice a year, and the results are presented within 6 months of the completion of fieldwork. The LFS uses concepts and definitions consistent with those issued by the International Labour Organization for such surveys. It covers all districts of the Cayman Islands. In addition to labour force tables, the Report includes population estimates for the Cayman Islands.</p>	<p><u>Report Period:</u> <u>Release Date</u> April 2026: September 30, 2026 October 2026: March 31, 2027</p>

<p>Quality of Life Reports The Quality of Life Report (QoL) is conducted twice a year, and the results are presented within 6 months of the completion of fieldwork. <p>Quarterly Trade Bulletins These bulletins present summaries of the merchandise import data compiled for the quarter from the Customs Department's database. <p>System of National Accounts Report 2025 The System of National Accounts Report presents estimates of the country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) using the production, expenditure, and income approaches, based on the international <i>System of National Accounts (2008)</i> concepts and methodology. The completion and release of this report are contingent on the timely transfer of data from partner agencies and other data-gathering agencies.</p>	<p><u>Target release date</u> October 2026</p>
<p>Third Quarter Economic Report, January-September 2026 The Third Quarter Economic Report, January-September 2026, uses available data from the first nine months of the year for its economic analyses. The report provides a snapshot of the year's economic conditions using available indicators, preliminary data, and forecasts. The completion and release of this report are contingent on the timely transfer of data from partner agencies and other data-gathering agencies.</p>	<p><u>Target release date</u> January 2027</p>
<p>Annual Economic Report 2026 The Annual Economic Report 2026 uses available data for the year for its economic analyses. The report is intended to provide a review of the year's economic conditions using indicators from domestic sectors, regional and institutional agencies, and their forecasts. This report included forecasts of economic variables for the next three years, based on available information at the time of publication approval. The completion and release of this report are contingent on the timely transfer of data from partner agencies and other data-gathering agencies.</p>	<p><u>Target release date</u> May 2027</p>
<p>Labour Market Analysis Report The Labour market analysis report will focus on the supply and demand for workers, examining trends in employment, skills, wages, and demographics to understand job availability and economic conditions. It involves analyzing LFS data on job seekers (supply) and employers' needs (demand).</p>	<p><u>Target release date</u> June 2026</p>
